



**TERMS OF SERVICE FOR THE LOGMEIN FANOCRACY WEBINAR PROGRAM**

**NO PURCHASE REQUIRED TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING A REWARD. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.**

13. **DISPUTES:** Except where prohibited, you agree that any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the Program or any reward awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, your rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of LogMeIn in connection with the Program, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of Massachusetts, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of Massachusetts or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than Massachusetts.
